MEETING PROGRAMME AND ACTIVITIES:

01/02/2015 – Sunday

Arrival to Leszno, hotel „Glinding Hotel“

02/02/2015 – Monday

All the participants were transported by host country to I Zespół Szkół im. Stanisława Staszica in Wschowa after the breakfast at hotel. The meeting began with welcome greetings from students in national Polish costumes and from the head of the school Mrs. Damian Janowicz. We watched the presentation of the host country and event in school gym. The host country presented the folk music and the folkloric dances of Poland. Welcome concert started with a beautiful Polish polonez. Dances were presented by folk group "Żeńcy Wielkopolscy" from Śmigiel.

After the concert each partner was called one by one to the stage for being given the gifts prepared by the host country. On the behalf of the group. The coordinator of the each country had a thank you speech.

Later we had the possibility to look around the school buildings.

After a short coffee break was a city game for all of us. It was a trip around Wschowa. We learned about the sights and the history of Wschowa.

Then we had a lunch in CKUiP Wshowa

After the lunch we got back to the meeting room. Firstly all partners shared gifts and then all countries presented their project activities.

1st Romanian team: Constantin and Aleksandra showed a Power Point presentation about Romanian food.

2nd Turkish team: Guvenc showed a presentation and a video which is about traditional food and weddings ceremony.

3rd Signe and Cornelia from Estonia talked about Project activities. They had a short video about Estonian food and weddings.

4th Olga from Latvia showed presentation about Latvian food.

6th Emilia from Bulgaria showed Power Point presentation materials on food.

5th Hungarian team: Eva presented a Power Point about Hungarian food.

6th Emilia from Bulgaria showed Power Point presentation materials on food.

7th Monika from Poland did own presentation about project activities.

After a short coffee break the teachers discussed the Project activities. Detailed planning of the activities 92-98 from the Application Form. Defining coordinators and deadlines for the tasks. We talked about project mobility and flash meeting. We decided that we use the Skype for flash meetings and Olga makes Skype group and gives to everyone the passwords.

We were talking about project mobilities:

Latvia: Planned 13 students and 11 teachers, done 13 students and 14 teachers

Romania: Planned 12 students and 12 teachers, done students and teachers

Estonia: Planned 12 students and 12 teachers, done 12 students and 12 teachers

Bulgaria: Planned 13 students and 11 teachers, done 11 students and 14 teachers

Hungary: Planned 14 students and 10 teachers, done 15 students and 13 teachers

Poland: Planned 16 students and 8 teachers, done 18 students and 10 teachers

Turkey: Planned 14 students and 10 teachers, done 16 students and 42 teachers

At the same time students were in a workshop where Mrs Krzysztof Rękoś taught them Polish polonez and in the evening students presented to teachers what they had learned.

While we were having dinner at Royal Castle „Zamek Krolewski“ in Wschowa. (Zamek Królewski we Wschowie) We left Wshowa at 21:30 and went back to „Glinding Hotel“.

03/02/2015 – Tuesday

After the breakfast at hotel all the participants were transported to Wschowa. All participants visited the County Authorities. Mayor Marek Boryczka. We could see a presentation about the Wschowa

After the short coffee break we continued the discussion of project activities and students were involved in the workshop. They did handicrafts and gypsum masks.

The main discussion topics focused on the tasks 99-106

Tasks n° 99 - each country making a brochure with pictures and information with students' researchers about wedding traditions.

Task n° 103,104 – Students and teachers make suggestions about the title and content for the last product – scenario for common European celebration. Students discuss the main characters. They discuss their ideas. Each country is going to make its own scenario (festival, wedding, holidays etc.)

After a lunch we visited the Public Library and Museum of Wschowa Region. We looked around and we were shown the technical options on the Library. And we studied the history of Wschowa.

Students were involved in workshop with folk and carnival elements and teachers continued discussion of project activities. We focused on the task 107-112, 120.

Task n° 107 – Flash meeting. Olga gave the Skype group name for flash meeting.

Task n° 113 – making a concert - European celebration. We decided that each country is going to do it in spring. We decided that we won't put a deadline for organizing a concert.

Güvenc presented a video about the Turkish wedding ceremony. He showed us two different versions. After that we went back to school and had a short coffee break.

Last meeting session was at school. Students learned Polish dances, games and competitions, but teachers were sharing experiences of flash meeting and discussing different ways of popularization of the project. Organizing the next meeting in Turkey and drawing conclusions.

Emilia pointed out an important issue of uploading all Project materials to project web site, etwinning, facebook, youtube or school web site. Each country must make their own common products (leaflet, brochures or videos) of the project.

All partners decided:

1) Students writing essays about weddings. Bulgaria gives information to Latvia, Latvia gives information to Poland, Poland gives information to Turkey, Turkey gives information to Hungary, Hungary to Estonia and Estonia to Romania. Each country is going to write differences and similarities about wedding ceremony.

2) All countries are sending to Signe podcasting about weddings (task n° 93), film about wedding performance (task n° 95), PowerPoint presentation about weddings

(task n° 96), making brochure with pictures about weddings (task n° 99), summary scenario for common European celebration in English (task n° 106), (Power Point) for students ideas (task n° 109), making animations of the story (task n° 111). All teams are responsible about collecting materials and sending them to Signe.

3) For last meeting in Turkey all countries are making presentations about weddings, scenario for European celebration and extra activities.

4) All partners share CD or DVD disc in Turkey. CD disc must include all presentations of the final products.(videos, presentations, brochures, leaflets etc.)

5) Turkey would like to know how many people are visiting Turkey. Sharing information deadline is 9.02-15.02.15

6) Questionnaire. Signe shares the questionnaire for everyone. 10 students from each county have to fill this questionnaire and then make a summary.

Some partners showed us the album about the meetings. It was a pleasure to see again the nice moments of time spent together.

The host school hands the certificates to the teachers and the students during the ceremony.

The day ended with a Polish evening – with national music, dances and costumes and dishes in a typical Polish restaurant WIGWAMY in Śmigiel

04/02/2015 – Wednesday
